Due to Provincial Regulations and Licenses the following rules governing liquor consumption and smoking apply:

LIQUOR CONSUMPTION POLICY

The Debert Hospitality Centre is fully licensed throughout the facility with the exception of our bedroom areas. We have clear guidelines within our Special Premises License with regards to how our license works and we ask for our client's cooperation to ensure that we maintain our license for all our clients. We asks that all guests staying at this facility observe and comply with the following rules regarding consumption of alcohol as set out in our License:

- All guests bringing in personal liquor are required to consume it within the bedroom/common areas. No personal liquor is to be transported into any part of the main facility or outside of the buildings.
- All liquor purchased from the bar areas of the main facility including the patio areas and is not permitted to be transported back to any bedroom/common areas.

SMOKING POLICY

Effective Dec 1st, 2006, this facility has enforced smoke free regulations within the whole complex including the patios adjacent to the bar areas. Smoking regulations also do not permit smoking within 13 feet of any door or window. As a result smoking is no longer permitted in any entrance of the facility. Designated smoking areas have been identified please check with office staff that will advise you of the smoking areas.

We thank all of our guests for your cooperation in observing these rules and regulations as legislated by the Province of NS and the Alcohol and Gaming Corporation.
